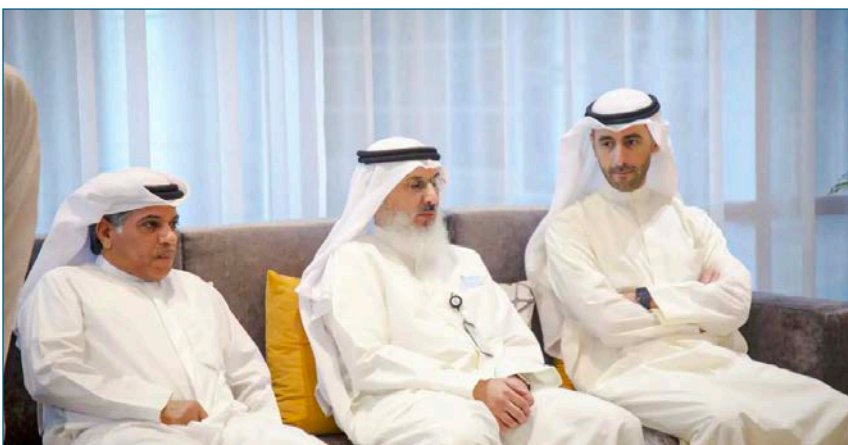

KIPIC Received Student Delegation from the Australian University of Kuwait

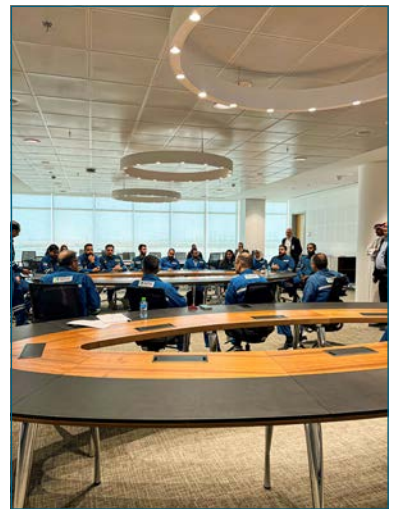
