On Wednesday, September 14, 2022 in Al-Zour 2, the General Services Group, in cooperation with the General Department of anti-drug in the Ministry of Interior, organized a lecture on the scourge of drugs and its impact on society, with the aim of educating employees and their children about the damages of this scourge and how to combat it. The lecture, presented by Lt. Col. Muhammad Al-Mutairi, Officer of the Awareness Department, presented the dangers of drugs, which damage the cells of the nervous system and all cells of the body, in addition to their effects on the body of the abuser and the various diseases resulting from it such as AIDS, leukemia and hepatitis, as well as how to identify the abuser or addict. Through his actions and outward appearance. The
