




• WIPO Award: A Transformative Innovation

Ophthalmology Senior Specialist -Al-Ahmadi Hospital

Success of the First Corneal Transplant.. A Major Medical Achievement at Al-Ahmadi Hospital

In a significant advancement for ocular services at Al-Ahmadi Hospital, Ophthalmology Senior Specialist Dr. Faisal Musaed Al-Jassar successfully performed the first corneal transplant at the hospital.

Al-Jassar joined the hospital a little over a year ago with the goal of enhancing surgical services in the field of ophthalmology, particularly with regard to corneal cases. These services include simple and sophisticated cataract procedures, as well as correction of the anterior segment of the eye.

During this meeting, Al-Jassar presents the details of this achievement, the challenges encountered, and his vision for the future of corneal transplantation in Kuwait. Provide us with details regarding the successful completion of the first corneal transplant at Al-Ahmadi Hospital, as well as the current status of the patient who received the procedure

Al-Ahmadi Hospital is the first of its kind in a series of operations that will be carried out in the field of vision correction. This operation is considered to be one of the more complex operations, and it was carried out on a patient who was 70 years old and was suffering from a number of eye impairments, including weakness in the optic nerve. Where he underwent a corneal lining procedure, which was crowned with success, thank God, as the patient immediately noticed a considerable improvement in his vision one week following the operation, and he is now undergoing periodic followups.

• From where was the cornea sourced?

- The cornea had been sourced from the United States one day prior to the operation.

• How is corneal transplantation different from other medical procedures, and why is it considered a major milestone for the hospital?

Corneal transplantation is a critical procedure for addressing corneal diseases that result in reversible blindness. These procedures were not performed on a regular basis at Al-Ahmadi Hospital. It is crucial to note that there are several types of corneal transplantation, including total corneal transplantation and an alternate partial transplantation. Additionally, there are operations that replace only the inner corneal part, the front parts, the front two-thirds while preserving the inner part, and the inner part only. Through these procedures, the hospital aims to alleviate patients' pain and provide them with comprehensive care, as part of its ongoing efforts to consistently provide outstanding services.

What is the significance of these procedures for patients?

Corneal transplantation is a procedure that helps restore sight to individuals suffering from corneal failure, a significant cause of blindness that can occur at a rate of up to 5%. Therefore, these procedures are absolutely necessary to enhance the patients' quality of life.

• What is the success rate of such operations?

Corneal transplantation is one of the most successful organ transplants, surpassing liver and kidney transplants in terms of success. This is due to the cornea's lack of blood vessels, which facilitates its acceptance by the body. However, the success of the transplant is dependent on the type of condition for which it was performed, and the success rate is influenced by whether the patient has undergone corneal transplants previously. Keratoconus patients typically experience a higher success rate with the transplant operation. Conversely, the success rate decreases as the number of failed transplants increases.

What types of corneal transplants have the highest success rate?

The most successful corneal transplants are always partial, as the rejection rate is higher for a complete corneal transplantation. Rejection typically begins in the inner part of the cornea, so if the inner part is retained and only the two front parts are replaced, the success rate is more optimal.

• What are the causes of corneal diseases?

There are several factors to consider; it could stem from a genetic congenital condition or arise from complications following a prior eye surgery that affected the cornea. Frequent eye rubbing in children can result in alterations to the curvature of the cornea, known as astigmatism, and unsuccessful LASIK procedures may contribute to corneal diseases.





Adherence to instructions after transplantation

Dr. Al-Jassar emphasised the necessity of following physicians' directives and maintaining consistent follow-up after corneal transplantation to guarantee the operation's success and achieve optimal outcomes for the patient.



• What were the most prominent challenges you faced during the procedure?

The challenges encountered prior to the procedure were primarily logistical and organisational. They involved the preparation of essential medical equipment, the procurement of corneas from international banks in the United States, and the coordination with a skilled medical team. It also necessitated compliance with the stringent criteria for organ transplantation to guarantee the success of the procedure.

The success of the procedure was due to the experienced team of nursing and assistant staff members who worked under the supervision of the administration of the hospital. These individuals made significant efforts to facilitate the preparation of equipment, speed up the process of requesting a cornea, and ensure that the work flowed smoothly during the procedure itself, which lasted between 30 and 45 minutes. Following the completion of the treatment, the patient's condition was evaluated, and his condition was carefully watched to guarantee that the anticipated outcomes were accomplished.

• At the present time, the discipline of ophthalmology consists of precise specialisations. Could you provide further information regarding yours?

Corneal transplantation is a highly specialised field that necessitates a fellowship that lasts for five years and requires the individual to take part in a significant number of procedures in order to acquire the requisite experience. Furthermore, it is essential that the patient is informed of the significance of ongoing follow-up following surgical procedures.

Describe a personal situation that has had a significant impact on you throughout your professional career.

I remember a young man, merely twenty-five years of age, who experienced a loss of vision as a consequence of overlooked keratoconus. He remarked to me postoperation, "This is the first time I have seen you, Doctor." That moment had a profound impact on my perspective.

• What are your future aspirations in this field?

I aspire to create a dedicated centre for ocular research and surgical procedures in Kuwait, along with developing local fellowship programmes aimed at training physicians in corneal transplantation. Additionally, I envision an innovation hub focused on medical devices for ocular health.

• What are the most significant factors that influence eye health?

A multitude of elements, such as hereditary influences, prolonged periods of darkness, inadequate nutrition, and the overuse of electronic devices, adversely impact optical well-being. Consequently, the prompt identification of asymptomatic conditions is crucial for the maintenance of visual acuity.

A Kuwaiti Champion's Path to Success Between Trap Shooting and Her Career



In this engaging interview, we feature the Kuwaiti Trap Shooting champion Reem Al-Zamanan, who has garnered numerous notable accomplishments in her athletic career, alongside her professional success at Kuwait National Petroleum Company (KNPC). We will explore her origins, the methods she employed to harmonise her professional responsibilities with her training, the obstacles she encountered in a predominantly male environment, and the influence of Trap Shooting on her character and everyday life.



To begin with, we are eager to understand the origins of your journey in the field of Trap Shooting. What motivated you to pursue a career in this domain?

I commenced my practice in Trap Shooting during the middle of 2023. However, my enthusiasm was first ignited when I randomly encountered this sport during the 2012 London Olympics. From that point onwards, I resolved to delve into the intricacies of this sport and engage in its practice. Despite not being able start at that time, I sustained my passion until I completed my university education and began to realise my aspirations. I distinctly recall the profound impression I experienced upon witnessing the players' remarkable performance during my initial viewing.

What were your emotions upon achieving victory and securing the gold medal for the Kuwait women's national team? What are the most significant moments from that experience?

The thrill of receiving the gold medal was beyond articulation, particularly as it marked my first-ever achievement on the international stage. A profoundly memorable experience etched in my mind is the moment I stood on the podium, raised the Kuwaiti flag, and sang the national anthem.

• What obstacles did you face during your sporting career? And how did you handle them?

As with any athlete, I encountered numerous obstacles throughout my career, each distinct and varying in their characteristics from one individual to

another. Nonetheless, the most significant obstacles I encountered were navigating the complexities of being a left-handed participant in a predominantly male sport while managing a demanding schedule.

• What is your daily training routine? And how do you manage to work at the Kuwait National Petroleum Company while still practicing for sports?

My daily routine hinges on the delicate equilibrium between professional commitments, Trap Shooting pursuits, and social engagements, with effective time management serving as the crucial element in attaining this harmony. Given that trap Trap Shooting necessitates daylight, it became imperative to meticulously organise my schedule, as I proceed to training directly following my work hours. I express my gratitude for the supportive work environment fostered by understanding and encouraging managers, which has facilitated a harmonious balance between my professional responsibilities and personal pursuits. am truly appreciative of being a member of the Kuwait National Petroleum Company family, a company that profoundly values and supports its employees. This support significantly influences the achievement and distinction of athletes.

• What strategies do you employ to sustain your concentration during competitive events? Are there particular methods you employ to manage pressure and tension effectively?

The act of Trap Shooting is predominantly governed by mental acuity rather than mere physical prowess. Upon



entering the Trap Shooting range, it is essential to clear my mind and concentrate on my established procedures prior to taking a shot. I strive to eliminate any potential distractions, be they thoughts or uncertainties, to ensure that I can arrive at the most appropriate decision at the opportune moment. Irrespective of whether I achieve the objective, I strive to set aside past outcomes and concentrate on the new goal as though it were my initial endeavour.

 Do you have an athlete whom you regard as a paragon in the realm of Trap Shooting? What guidance would you offer to aspiring individuals seeking to pursue a career in this domain?

I regard "Xin Zhang" as a profound source of inspiration, being the first woman to win an Olympic gold medal in Trap Shooting and the first to triumph in a mixed-gender competition throughout the history of the Olympic Games, alongside her remarkable accomplishment of setting a world record. I encourage young individuals to pursue their passions, be it in athletics or their chosen professions, and to embody patience and perseverance, as achieving success necessitates both time and diligent effort.

• Do the competencies you developed through athletics enhance your professional efficacy? In what manner might one achieve that?

Indeed, the competencies acquired through sportssuch as discipline, perseverance, flexibility, patience, commitment, the capacity for rapid decision-making under pressure, and the assurance of timely task execution—have had significant benefits in the professional sphere. The manifestation of these skills in professional contexts is evident, as they enhance



productivity and facilitate concentration on tasks, enabling the formulation of wise decisions even amidst challenges. This has significantly influenced my achievements in both individual and collaborative endeavours.

• What inspired you to volunteer at Dar al Athar al Islamiyyah, and how did you begin your journey there?

When the Treasures of the World: Indian Goldsmith Arts in the Mughal Era, the first exhibition at the American Cultural Centre, opened in 2011, I saw an advertisement asking for volunteers to act as museum guides. I eagerly volunteered, driven by my passion for museums, exhibitions, and the wealth of knowledge they offer. This presented an excellent chance for me to gain knowledge and make a positive impact on others.

I have consistently felt a deep commitment to helping others and contributing to society, which led me to engage in various volunteer activities, including reading to children, participating in agriculture and greening initiatives, and conducting research and documentation.

A Volunteer's Journey: From a Museum Guide to Inspiration for Young Minds

• Share your insights on instructing children in the realm of history and art—what key aspects do you emphasise during your lessons? What is the reason for focusing on children?

Upon beginning my tenure at the museum, I observed a need for volunteers in the educational programme. Consequently, alongside my role as a museum guide, I contributed to the development of educational initiatives. In what ways does your background in the oil and gas industry influence your contributions as a culture and heritage volunteer?

She initiated several projects, including the "Ear Saver" initiative, inspired by her colleague, Engineer Reem Bastaki from the Kuwait National Petroleum Company (KNPC). Consequently, she organised a group of volunteer campaigns to make masks and distribute them across different regions of Kuwait for individuals in multiple sectors, including the Ministry of Health and the airport. This initiative broadened its scope to encompass the coverage of tuition fees for underprivileged students, financed through the proceeds from the sale of woollen ribbons. She states, "I recognised the significance of my efforts when I observed the appreciation reflected in the eyes of the students and their parents who I assisted."

Challenges of Volunteer Work

Latifah perceives the primary challenge as the balance between her professional responsibilities and her contributions to the community. She accomplished this by designating vacation periods and official holidays for the purpose of engaging in volunteer work. She states, "I encountered challenges in engaging children and youth in volunteer work due to their apparent disinterest; however, I managed to incorporate entertaining elements to draw them in."

Additionally, there is the issue of skepticism surrounding volunteer efforts and charitable organisations, as individuals often question whether donations truly reach those who deserve them. I hold no resentment toward them, as I once shared a similar perspective. However, my engagement in volunteer work, particularly in overseeing donations, distributing them, and ensuring they reach those in need alongside my team, has profoundly transformed my viewpoint. This experience has instilled in me a deeper appreciation for the significance of volunteer efforts, regardless of their scale.

Naemati Initiative: An Initiative Aimed at Safeguarding Resources and Assisting the Underprivileged

I am deeply proud of the "Naemati Initiative," a volunteer project that aims to preserve blessings, safeguard our environment, and provide sustenance to families in need. The initiative focuses on the collection of surplus food that is nearing its expiration date yet remains suitable for consumption. However, it cannot be sold due to regulations that restrict the sale of food products prior to their expiration by a duration of 3 to 6 months. We source the food items from various stores and suppliers within a designated hall, pack them into boxes, and distribute them using vehicles equipped with refrigeration technology. This initiative, organised by our team on a nearly monthly basis, has garnered significant impact and recognition both locally and internationally.

• Converting Skills into Volunteer Assistance

I am eternally thankful to have implemented my talent not merely as a pastime but also in conducting workshops for volunteers, instructing them in the development of small handicraft projects. The concept involved educating volunteers to evolve into trainers,



thereby imparting knowledge to others and fostering a sustainable cycle of skill transfer.

A moment of pride for me occurred when a trainee remarked, "I learnt from you how to create woven bookmarks, and I prepared several items and offered them for sale at a charity market held at school, subsequently donating the proceeds to assist our people in Gaza." This situation astonished me, as the trainee adeptly transformed a mere craft into a means of aiding others.

• In what ways has volunteering transformed your perspective or character?

Engaging in volunteer work illuminated the numerous blessings to which we have grown accustomed. It is essential to recognise the significance of every task, regardless of its simplicity, as even the most straightforward endeavours can hold substantial value in the eyes of our Creator and profoundly influence individuals and society at large. In addition to continuity and dedication, volunteer work is marked by its perpetual nature.



• Advice for Aspiring Documentary Filmmakers




How long does it take to work on preparing a piece or tune?

Abdullah's journey began when he participated in a series of external excursions arranged by a company that specialises in this area. Following numerous excursions, after that he joined the work team, taking on the role of guide and organiser for the trips. In this place, he realised that he had found himself in a field that resonated with his passion and eagerness to explore new places and experiences.

Creating Unique Experiences That Resonate with the Passion of Adventurers

Abdullah states, "We offer a variety of creative travel experiences." One example is the "Stargasing Trip" that we organised in collaboration with A. Khaled Al-Jamaan, a leading astronomer in Kuwait. The geological "Al-Mutlaa Hills Trip" offers an opportunity to explore the most beautiful and unique rock formations in the State of Kuwait, in collaboration with geological engineer Yousef Al-Shatti. Additionally, we established a social excursion category, featuring events like "Girgee'an Al-Julaiah" and "Graish at the Farm," which provide participants with the opportunity to explore Kuwaiti cultural heritage in a delightful tourist setting. Regarding the target groups, over ten trips were organised, each distinct in concept and execution. The nature of the trip often dictates the type of participants involved, whether they are young, old, or a combination of both.

From a Golf Tournament to Mubarakiya

Sudan acquired valuable experience through the organisation of numerous events in his professional field across different companies in the oil sector, including a golf tournament during his tenure at Kuwait Petroleum Corporation (KPC). He was selected by the team to serve as a tour guide for the delegations involved in the tournament, as he initiated the first official trip to Mubarakiya, which subsequently became his preferred spot for local tourism. Alongside the valuable experience he acquired at Kuwait Oil Company (KOC), where he coordinated numerous company events and activities. "All of these experiences, which I take pride in, have played a significant role in enhancing my organisational and administrative skills," he expressed.

"National Day Fiesta" and the Legacy of Family Heritage

Sudan explains that the National Day Fiesta trip, named "Al-Khatawi Al Akidah," originated from a family tradition. During his childhood, they would rent a bus to explore different areas of Kuwait in celebration of National Day. Through his project, he successfully preserved this custom and revived it by organising the largest and most comprehensive National Day Fiesta trip each year. During last year's trip, he provided participants with a popular women's band that accompanied them throughout the journey, enriching the experience with timeless patriotic songs that significantly contributed to the joy of Liberation Day.



What makes this initiative unique compared to others?

The primary aspect of my project is to emphasise local tourism in Kuwait. As many individuals concentrated on international travel, I chose to shift my focus to local tourism. Particularly during the Corona pandemic and the airport closures, there emerged a significant demand for local entertainment among the populace. Following that organisational experience, we found that there are remarkable locations within our cherished country that many might be unaware of, including the Liberation Tower Museum. We were eager to be among the first to explore it during one of our journeys.

The primary objective of his project is to inform people that Kuwait is more than merely an oil-rich nation; it is a captivating country filled with numerous hidden gems of unexplored landmarks and experiences, known to both citizens and residents alike. His extensive studies abroad deepened this notion and fueled his envy for his homeland, as he uncovered that Kuwait is home to enchanting locations that have not been given the attention they deserve. As someone who enjoys delving into and discovering new experiences, he felt that arranging these trips showcases his enthusiasm for sharing the beauty of Kuwait with others.

What challenges does Abdullah Sudan encounter in coordinating local tourism?

Frankly, the primary challenge lencounter is that certain individuals are unwilling to acknowledge the expenses associated with participating in these trips. Many individuals think that the costs are elevated, not fully appreciating the expertise involved in the organisation or the variety of services offered throughout the journey. We aim to create a refined and inviting atmosphere that upholds our esteemed reputation. It is encouraging to observe that numerous former participants, having experienced our programme, choose to join us again, fostering a welcoming social atmosphere. Additionally, there were family members among the participants. Another challenge is the high temperature in the summer, which led me to develop activities that are appropriate for the hot weather, such as the "Al-Qambar" activity, which is a traditional fishing method performed during the night. This educational initiative promotes the rituals of Kuwait's maritime heritage in an innovative manner that caters to all groups.

Balancing Work and Enthusiasm: How Does Abdullah Sudan Maintain Equilibrium Between His Professional Responsibilities and His Personal Project?

Managing a job alongside a personal project presents challenges, yet through effective time organisation and task delegation, Abdullah successfully found this equilibrium. Fortunately, everything is progressing as he described.
